As a society you would want your information to remain within your society. As an individual, you would want your data to remain in your control all the time. You should have a choice on what to share and what not.

### **External Service Providers**

We do not disclose your personal information to external service providers unless you provide your explicit consent. To prevent our disclosure of your personally identifiable information to an external service provider, you can decline such consent or simply not use their services. ### **Public Information**

This page is used to inform users / visitors regarding our policies with the collection, use, and disclosure of Personal Information if anyone decided to use our Service.

We build applications for housing societies which can help to society in their management, work, accounting, security and others. We built the apps i.e. DreamZSociety, HousingSocietyClub, MyGate as a free app. Any society can use our services in variety of ways to manage privacy.

We want you to understand the types of information we collect as you use our services.

When you're not signed into our mobile or web application, we collect basic information i.e. unique identifier, browser, application, or device you're using. This helps us do things like maintain your browsing sessions.

When you're signed in via third party authentication provider service, we collect information like Authentication provider token, unique identifier, browser, application, or device you're using, email Id, which we treat as personal information.

When you're signed in with our own authentication mechanism, we collect information like unique identifier, browser, application, or device you're using, email Id, which we treat as personal information.

### **What information do we collect?**

We collect information from you when you register on our site, filling out any form. When registering on our site, fill out any form, as appropriate, you may be asked to enter your: name, e-mail address, residential address, mailing address or phone number.

### **What do we use your information for?**

Your information, whether public or private, will not be sold, exchanged, transferred, or given to any other company for any reason whatsoever, without your consent, other than for the express purpose of delivering the service requested.

### **Third party websites**

## **Use of Cookies**

These are objects placed in a computer which enables the web server to identify and track the web browser.
